

The King Maker

November 2024

It's that time again. Every four years in the Good Ole USA our election includes a check box for President of The United States. Every four years people say "This is the most important election of our lifetime." I'm not sure how that's possible but they say it anyway. What it is for sure is a media frenzy and a boon for the industry of fear mongering. That is for certain. When God freed the Israelites from Egypt, He knew that they wanted a king. Freedom is scary – some things never change. Deuteronomy 17 tells how God warned them to not let the government get too big and to have politicians that do not think too highly of themselves or get caught up in greed, lest his heart be led astray.
